# Preparing for fight against Asian Hornet. Our Branch Asian Hornet Strategy

With so many Asian Hornet nests found last year, it is inevitable that some queens will be establishing new nests this year. The most effective way of controlling numbers is by spring trapping. This meeting will explain the practicability of how to trap queens. How your beekeeping practice will need to change to reduce predation by Asian Hornets will also be explained. We urge all members to attend this important meeting. Even those of you who do not have bees can make a vital contribution to trapping the new queens this Spring.

Simple traps costing just £1 will be available at this meeting, along with a quantity of attractant available free, but please bring your own container (such as a milk bottle or shampoo bottle).

With the beginning of the year concentrating on the need to fight against the Asian Hornet, the next three meetings of the indoor programme are focussed on reminding us of the fun of beekeeping.
